DIRECTIONS:

From the M65: Exit at Junction 8 heading north on the A6068, signposted Clitheroe, Whalley and Padiham. Continue straight over the next crossroads, staying on the A6068 until you meet the junction with the A671 where you turn left towards Clitheroe and Whalley. After about 1½ miles (during which you will pass through the outskirts of 'Simonstown' and 'Read') - you should see a row of house on your left side where you will turn left down a very narrow lane. Immediately after the last house! As far I can see there is no signpost on that corner - hence the reason I have high-lighted it on the map shown on the left!



The site is about 300 yards further on down that lane - which only leads to the camp site - so telephone ahead and you should not meet anything coming the other way. Fingers crossed!

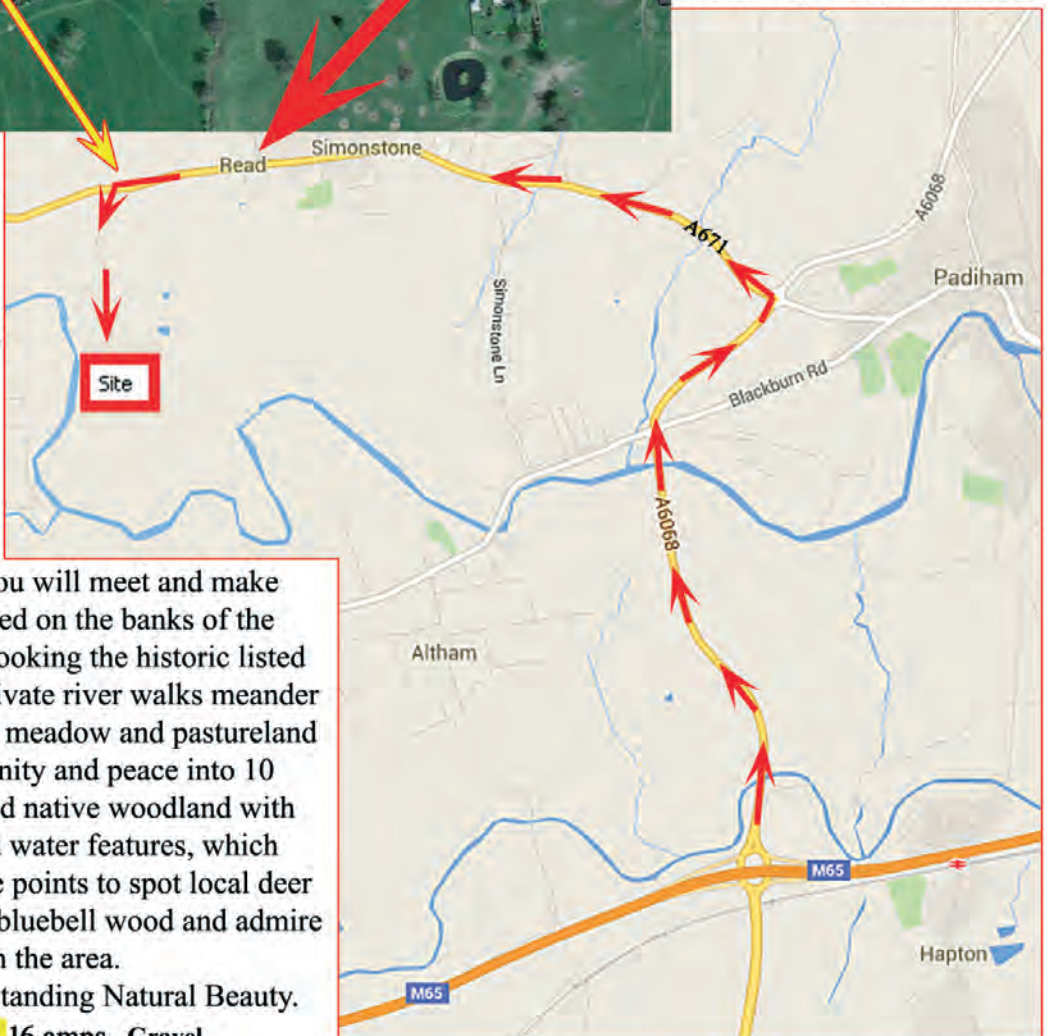
