Explore the Magnificent Weston Park

Weston Park is a magnificent 17th century stately home on the Shropshire/Staffordshire border, built in 1671 by Lady Elizabeth Wilbraham and set in 1,000 acres of Capability Brown Parkland.

A most welcoming stately home, much of its appeal stems from the collecting ambitions of the Newport and Bridgeman families with Weston now home to an internationally important art collection. Gifted to the nation in 1986, the Weston Park Foundation who now own and maintain the estate will be celebrating its 30th birthday in 2016.

Wander the Front Hall, with its tribute to the 3rd Earl's love of horses and make your way into the Victorian Library, which is furnished with over 3,000 books. Enjoy the unique Gobelin tapestries, specially commissioned for the House, then enter the stunning Dining Room, which houses one of the country's most impressive collections of paintings including works by renowned artists such as Sir Anthony Van Dyck.
