DIRECTIONS: Very simple and straightforward for this site - navigate yourself onto the A947 just a couple of hundred yards to the south side of Turriff and you will see the site entrance on the north-east side of the road.

Next to the boating pond and Haughs Park, where the annual Turriff Agricultural Show is held in early August, the site is ideal as a base for those who want to explore the area, with access to both the whisky and castle trails. Don't miss the chance to visit beautiful Fyvie Castle, just south of Turriff, or Delgatie Castle with its award-winning Laird's kitchen. For those who enjoy outdoor activities this is an ideal area for cycling, fishing, shooting and horse-riding.
